[REDACTED] joined the Humanitas Trust in 2[REDACTED] and served with distinction across more than a decade of dedicated service. His commitment to our mission — the continuation and flourishing of humanity — was evident in everything he did. He was known to his colleagues as a man of exceptional integrity, quiet resolve, and an unwavering belief in what we are building together.

The safety of our people is the highest priority of the Humanitas Trust and the Global Continuity Initiative. A full investigation has been initiated in strict accordance with GCI Operations Protocol 7.4. We are cooperating fully with all relevant parties and will share findings with our team as they become available. We ask that all personnel respect the integrity of this process.

In accordance with the wishes of his family, memorial arrangements will remain private. A service will be held at [REDACTED] on [REDACTED], 2[REDACTED]. Details will not be made public.

[REDACTED] believed in what we are building. His legacy lives in the mission he gave his life to serve. We carry his dedication forward.
